An Act to amend "The In Rem Tax Forcelosure Act (1948)," approved May 28, 1948 (P. L. 1948, c. 96).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. Section 6 of chapter 96 of the laws of 1948 is amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 6. No action may be instituted under this act on any tax sale
- 4 certificate unless:
- 5 a. More than 2 years have expired from the date of the tax sale
- 6 out of which any such certificate arose, and
- 7 b. [For the 4 calendar years next preceding the commencement
- 8 of the action, no part of any general land taxes levied and assessed
- 9 against the land covered by such certificate has been paid.]
- 10 All or any portion of the general land taxes levied and assessed
- 11 against the land for the *[4 years]* *48 months* next preceding the
- 12 commencement of the action, other than those subject to payment by
- 13 installments authorized by a resolution adopted pursuant to Re-
- 14 vised Statutes 54:5-65, remains unpaid.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
