AN ACT concerning the office of county superintendents of schools and amending section 18A:7-6 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 18A:7-6 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to 2 read as follows:

The county superintendent shall maintain an office at [the county 3 seat,] a suitable location within the county which shall be open to 4 the public as are other county offices and which shall be supplied 5 to him, and shall be suitably furnished and equipped, by the board 6 of chosen freeholders of the county, and the school records of the 7 county for the use of the county and State Departments of Educa-8 tion, the United States Office of Education and the United States 9 Commissioner of Education shall be kept at such office. 10

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
