INTRODUCED MAY 6, 1968

By Assemblymen GIMSON and EWING

- An Act to amend "An act creating the New Jersey Racing Commission and defining its powers and duties; providing for the granting of permits and licenses for the operation of race meetings whereat the running, steeplechase racing or harness racing of horses only may be conducted; providing for the licensing of concessionaires and operators and their employees; regulating the system of pari-mutuel betting and fixing the license fees, taxes and revenues imposed hereunder and fixing penalties for violations of the provisions of this act," approved March 18, 1940 (P. L. 1940, c. 17), as said Title was amended by chapter 137 of the laws of 1941.
- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

Section 24 of the act of which this act is amendatory (C. 5:5-44)
is amended to read as follows:

3 24. In the event any person, partnership, association or corporation is granted a permit under this act to conduct a race meeting 4 pursuant to provisions thereof, such permit shall be renewed upon $\mathbf{5}$ application of the permit holder yearly for the next succeeding 6 10 years, for the same dates allotted to such permit holder during 7 the preceding year, where it is in the public interest to do so, or 8 for such other dates (not exceeding 56 racing days in the aggregate 9 for running racing and not exceeding 100 days in the aggregate 10 for harness racing) [as such permit holder shall request] as the 11 commission shall designate; provided, however, that commencing 12with the year [1963] 1968 the commission may also allot [among] 13 14 to each of the existing permit holders [the additional] 4 racing 15 days for running racing in addition to those herein authorized[, 16 such]; provided, however, that should any permit holder reject any or all of such additional days, the commission may allot them, 17 or any of them, among the remaining permit holders. FISCAL NOTE TO ASSEMBLY, No. 745

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: MAY 27, 1968

Assembly Bill No. 745 is an act that would amend the act creating the New Jersey Racing Commission so as to allot to each of the existing permit holders 4 additional racing days.

Based on previous experience, the Department of the Treasury estimates that enactment of Assembly Bill No. 745 should produce net revenues for the State of \$1,986,000.00 in each of the next 2 fiscal years.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.

SPONSOR'S STATEMENT FISCAL DATA

This bill provides for 100 days of harness horse racing instead of 60 and prohibits racing prior to March 1 instead of April 1.

It is estimated that the additional days of racing would result in an increase in State revenues of about \$1,000,000.00 with a cost to the State of approximately \$18,000.00.
