An Act concerning vocational schools and amending section 18A:54-23 of the New Jersey Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. Section 18A:54-23 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 18A:54-23. The boards of education of schools established under
- 4 the provisions of section 18A:54-12 in any county of the third
- 5 class with a population not less than 60,000 nor more than 100,000,
- 6 according to the 1960 Federal census, and the boards of education
- 7 of schools established under the provisions of section 18A:54-13,
- 8 shall receive pupils from districts without the county so far as their
- 9 facilities will permit, provided a rate of tuition not exceeding the
- 10 cost of such education as prescribed by rule of the commissioner,
- 11 approved by the State board, is paid by the sending districts.
- 12 The board of education of any county vocational school district
- 13 referred to in section 18A:54-11.1 and the board of education of
- 14 any other school district within the county thereof are each hereby
- 15 authorized and empowered to undertake and to enter into agree-
- 16 ments with respect to the attendance at schools of the county
- 17 vocational school district, of residents or pupils of such other school
- 18 district who are students attending the schools of the county
- 19 vocational school district and as to the payments to be made or the
- 20 rate of tuition to be charged on account of such students. The pay-
- 21 ment or rate of tuition per student shall be 50% of the pro rata
- 22 annual cost of the operation and maintenance of the county voca-
- 23 tional school district remaining after deduction from such cost of
- 24 all amounts of aid received by the county vocational school district
- 25 or the county thereof on account of such district or credited thereto
- 26 from the State of New Jersey or the United States of America or

27 agencies thereof, but excluding from such cost any amounts on 28 account of required payments of interest on or principal of bonds 29 or notes of the county issued for the purposes of such district. The annual aggregate amount of all of such payments or tuition 30 may be anticipated by the board of education of the county voca-31 32tional school district and by the board of chosen freeholders of the 33 county with respect to the annual budget of the county vocational school district. The amounts of all annual payments or tuition to 34 be paid by any such other school district shall be raised in each 35 year in the annual budget of such other school district and paid to 36 the county vocational school district. 37

The board of chosen freeholders of any county of the fourth class, 38 in which a county vocational school has been established shall be 39 entitled to collect and receive from the sending districts *in said 40 county* in which the pupils attending the vocational school reside, 41 42for the tuition of such pupils, a sum not exceeding the annual cost of education per pupil as determined according to rules prescribed 43by the commissioner and approved by the State board; provided, 44 however, that the maximum tuition per pupil shall be the pro rata 45annual cost of the operation and maintenance of said school remain-4647 ing after deduction from such cost of all amounts of aid received by the county vocational school or the county thereof on account of 48 such school or credited thereto from the State of New Jersey or the 49 United States of America or agencies thereof, but excluding from 50 such cost any amounts on account of required payments of interest 51 on or principal of bonds or notes of the county issued for the pur-52 poses of such school; and, provided further that the maximum 53 tuition per pupil shall not exceed the *average* annual cost of high 54school education per pupil in *[each]* *all* sending *[district]* 55 *districts* in the current year determined according to rules pre-56 scribed by the commissioner and approved by the State board and 5758 certified to the board of chosen freeholders of the county in which the vocational school has been established. Any difference between 59 the *average* cost of high school education per pupil in the respec-60 tive sending districts and in the vocational school shall be an 61 62 obligation of the board of chosen freeholders of the county in which said vocational school has been established. Such tuition shall be 63 established in advance of the school year by the board of chosen 64 freeholders, shall be certified to each sending district, and shall be 65paid quartely by the board of education of each sending district. 66

38 The board of chosen freeholders of any county of the fourth class, in which a county vocational school has been established shall be 39 entitled to collect and receive from the sending districts in which 40 the pupils attending the vocational school reside, for the tuition of 41such pupils, a sum not exceeding the annual cost of education per 42pupil as determined according to rules prescribed by the commis-43 sioner and approved by the State board; provided, however, that 44 the maximum tuition per pupil shall be the pro rata annual cost 45of the operation and maintenance of said school remaining after 4.6 deduction from such cost of all amounts of aid received by the 4748 county vocational school or the county thereof on account of such 49 school or credited thereto from the State of New Jersey or the 50 United States of America or agencies thereof, but excluding from such cost any amounts on account of required payments of interest 51 52on or principal of bonds or notes of the county issued for the pur-53 poses of such school; and, provided further that the maximum tuition per pupil shall not exceed the annual cost of high school 54education per pupil in each sending district in the current year 5556 determined according to rules prescribed by the commissioner and approved by the State board and certified to the board of chosen 57 freeholders of the county in which the vocational school has been 58 established. Any difference between the cost of high school educa-59 60 tion per pupil in the respective sending districts and in the vocational school shall be an obligation of the board of chosen free-61 holders of the county in which said vocational school has been 62established. Such tuition shall be established in advance of the 63 school year by the board of chosen freeholders, shall be certified 64 to each sending district, and shall be paid quarterly by the board 65of education of each sending district. 66
