AN ACT concerning highways and amending section 27:7-44.1 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 27:7-44.1 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read 2 as follows:

27:7-44.1. No consent, grant or franchise affecting any portion 3 of a State highway, or of any road included in the State highway 4 system, shall be given for the construction of a railroad or street  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 railway thereon except upon approval of and under conditions 7 acceptable to the commissioner; nor shall any person enter upon or construct any works in or upon any State highway, except under 8 such conditions and regulations as the commissioner may prescribe; 9 provided, however, the commissioner may lease land or property 10 under any viaduct or bridge, and the approaches thereto, said 11 property having been acquired for right of way purposes, to any 12municipal corporation or any public board or commission, for public 13use only, subject to such conditions and regulations as the commis-14 sioner shall prescribe. Whenever any encroachment may exist with-15out warrant of law in any road when taken over as a State highway, 16the commissioner shall notify the Attorney General, who shall 17 proceed to cause the same to be removed as by law provided. 18

Any person guilty of any violation of this section shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 for each day's violation, and the costs of prosecution, to be recovered by a civil action in the name of the State before any court of competent jurisdiction, by the commissioner. Said fines shall be paid into the State Treasury to the credit of the funds available for construction, maintenance and repair of roads. 26 Any such violation may be removed from any State highway as a

27 trespass by a civil action brought by the commissioner in the

28 Superior Court. The court may proceed in the action in a summary

29 manner or otherwise.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
