An Acr authorizing counties and municipalities to establish, maintain and appropriate funds for awards programs for their employees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. The board of chosen freeholders of any county or the govern-
- 2 ing body of any municipality may, by resolution, establish an
- 3 awards program or programs for county or municipal officers and
- 4 employees, as the case may be, designed to promote efficiency and
- 5 economy in governmental functions of the county or municipality
- 6 and to reward individual officers and employees for heroism, effi-
- 7 ciency, meritorious suggestions, professional accomplishments, per-
- 8 formance of duty and for service. The board or governing body
- 9 shall by such resolution provide for the administration of its
- 10 awards program or programs by an officer or officers named
- 11 therein and may provide for such advisory committee or commit-
- 12 tees to assist in the formulation and administration of such pro-
- 13 grams as it shall determine.
- 14 Awards, within available appropriations therefor, may be in
- 15 the form of cash, medals, certificates, insignia, or other appropri-
- 16 ate devices or tokens of appreciation as shall be provided for under
- 17 an established awards program.
  - 1 2. The board of chosen freeholders or governing body may ap-
- 2 propriate funds necessary to carry out any program or programs
- 3 established pursuant to this act.
- 1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
