INTRODUCED MARCH 25, 1968

AN ACT exempting members of the State Legislature from jury service, and amending section 2A:69-2 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2A:69-2 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 2A:69-2. The following persons shall be exempt from service  
4 on any panel of grand or petit jurors:

5 a. Members or employees of police forces, State or local.

6 b. Members of any fire department or fire patrol, volunteer or  
7 paid.

8 c. Persons appointed as fish and game wardens or protectors.

9 d. Regularly licensed and practicing physicians and dentists in  
10 this State.

11 e. Members of State or Federal military, naval or air forces.

12 f. School teachers while their schools are in session.

13 g. Any person who has the actual physical care and custody of  
14 a minor child and who gives written notice to the jury commis-  
15 sioners of the county of his residence that jury service would inter-  
16 fere with the care required for such child.

17 h. All officers and persons regularly employed by any agency  
18 under the authority of the State Board of Control of the Depart-  
19 ment of Institutions and Agencies, or regularly employed by hos-  
20 pitals.

21 i. Telegraph and telephone operators and linemen and those di-  
22 rectly engaged in the business of receiving and transmitting mes-  
23 sages by telegraph or calls by telephone.

24 j. Any person who is the holder of an exempt firemen's certificate  
25 issued pursuant to sections 40:47-52 to 40:47-59 of the Revised  
26 Statutes or any other law.

27 *k. Members of the State Legislature.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
