AN ACT to amend "An act concerning municipalities, and supplementing Title 40 of the Revised Statutes," approved July 21, 1941 (P. L. 1941 c. 277).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1941, c. 277 (C. 40:47-12.1) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 1. In the event of emergency or widespread conflagration, it
4 shall be lawful for the chief or other head of the fire or police
5 department of any municipality, upon the request of the chief of
6 the fire or police department or the mayor of any other munici-
7 pality for assistance, to provide and render such assistance, by
8 supplying fire and police aid, or both, in the protection of life and
9 property, or to assist in quelling any riot or disorder or in sup-
10 pressing any conflagration, and while so acting the members of
11 the fire or police department supplying such aid shall have the
12 same powers and authority as have the members of the fire or
13 police department of the municipality in which such aid is being
14 rendered.

15 Any member of a fire or police department rendering assistance
16 or aid, as contemplated by this act, who shall meet death in the
17 performance of duty, or who shall suffer sickness, injury or death
18 in carrying out the provisions of this act, shall be entitled to all
19 *salary, pension rights [and], workmen's compensation and other*
20 *benefits* as though such sickness, injury or death has occurred in
21 his own municipality.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
