An Act providing for the payment of pensions to widows of certain former State employees in certain cases.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1. If any person, heretofore having held employment in the State 1 $\mathbf{2}$ Department of Defense and in the former Quartermaster-General's 3 Department or the former Adjutant-General's Department con-4 tinuously for a period of 25 years or more and having been associated with the Senate of the State of New Jersey, serving in various 5 capacities as designated by the President of the Senate, continu-6 ously for a period in excess of 20 years, has died, having left a 7 widow, surviving him of the age of 60 years or more, such widow 8 shall be entitled to receive during the remainder of the term of her 9 natural life an annual pension of \$2,500.00 to be paid in equal semi-10 11 monthly payments by the State Treasurer. Such pension shall be payable upon application by any such widow to the State Treasurer 12 and shall be in lieu of any other pension she may be entitled to 13 14 receive from the State.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
