STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED JANUARY 29, 1968

By Senators McDERMOTT, RINALDO and LACORTE

Referred to Committee on Revision and Amendment of Laws

AN ACT to amend the "Good Samaritan Act" being chapter 140 of the laws of 1963, approved August 13, 1963.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New 2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to 2 read as follows:

3 1. Any *individual, including a* person licensed to practice any method of 4 treatment of human ailments, disease, pain, injury, deformity, mental or 5 physical condition, or licensed to render services ancillary thereto, who in 6 good faith renders emergency care at the scene of an accident or emergency 7 to the victim or victims thereof, shall not be liable for any civil damages as 8 a result of any acts or omissions by such person in rendering the emergency 9 care.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill would expand the statutory provisions of the Good Samaritan Act to include all who extend emergency aid.
