AN Act concerning the powers of the members of the marine police force in the Bureau of Navigation of the Department of Conservation and Economic Development, amending section 17 of the "New Jersey Boat Numbering Act of 1962" (P. L. 1962, c. 73) and section 2A:151-43 of the New Jersey Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 3 1. Section 17 of chapter 73 of the laws of 1962 is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 17. The department shall be responsible for the enforcement of
- 6 this act.
- 7 A supervisory force of marine patrolmen shall be formed and
- 8 their appointments, rank and pay shall be regulated by the Civil
- 9 Service Commission in compliance with the provisions of Title 11* [;]
- 10 members of the marine patrol force shall have the power of arrest].*
- 11 Harbor Masters and Power Vessel Inspectors shall hereafter be
- 12 known as marine patrolinen and those appointed in accordance
- 13 with Title 12 of the Revised Statutes will serve in accordance with
- 14 rules and regulations to be promulgated by the commission. *In
- 15 addition to any other powers provided by law, marine patrolmen
- 16 shall have the same powers as conferred upon harbor masters by
- 17 Revised Statutes 12:6-6.*
- 1 2. Section 2A:151-43 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 2A:151-43. Section 2A:151-41 of this Title does not apply to:
- 4 a. The United States Marshal or his deputies;

- 7 c. Any sheriff, undersheriff, county prosecutor, assistant prose-

- 9 d. The regularly employed members, including detectives, of
- 10 the police department of any county or municipality or of any
- 11 State, interstate, municipal or county park police force or of any
- 12 county boulevard police force at all times, while within the State
- 13 of New Jersey, or any special policeman appointed by the govern-
- 14 ing body of any county or municipality or by the commission or
- 15 other board or body having control of any county park police
- 16 force or any county boulevard police force while engaged in the
- 17 actual performance of his official duties and when specifically au-
- 18 thorized by the governing body to carry firearms;
- 19 e. Any member of the State Police, or any motor vehicle in-
- 20 spector;
- 21 f. Any jailer, constable, railway police, or any other peace officer,
- 22 when in discharge of his duties;
- 23 g. The members of the Fish and Game Council, or conservation
- 24 officers, or full-time employees of the Division of Shell Fisheries
- 25 having the power of arrest and authorized to carry weapons;
- 26 h. Any *[person] * *prison* or jail wardens or their deputies, or
- 27 any guard or keeper of any peual institution in this State, while
- 28 engaged in the actual performance of the duties of their positions
- 29 and when so required by their superior officers to carry firearms;
- 30 i. Any court attendant serving as such under appointment by
- 31 the sheriff of the county or by the judge of or magistrate of any
- 32 court of this State while in the performance of his duties;
- 33 j. (Deleted by amendment.)
- 34 k. Any guard in the employ of any railway express company.
- 35 banking or building and loan or savings and loan institution of
- 36 this State while in the performance of his duties;

- 40 orders, or any member thereof when going to or from the place
- 41 of meeting of the organization, carrying the weapons prescribed
- 42 for drill, exercise or parade;
- 13 n. Persons having a hunter's license in going to or from places
- 44 of hunting as set forth in section 2A:151-42:
- 45 o. Members of government or civilian rifle or pistol clubs duly

- 46 organized in accordance with the rules prescribed by the National
- 47 Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice, in going to or from
- 48 their several places of target practice and carrying weapons nec-
- 49 essary for such practice; provided further that a copy of the char-
- 50 ter is filed with the superintendent and a list of the members of
- 51 the club is submitted annually to the superintendent;
- 52 p. The director, deputy directors, inspectors and investigators
- 53 of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control in the Department
- 54 of Law and Public Safety;
- 55 q. Employees of public utility corporations actually engaged in
- 56 the transportation of explosives;
- 57 r. Any civil employee of the United States Government under
- 58 the supervision of the commanding officer of any post, camp, sta-
- 59 tion, base or other military or naval installation located within
- 60 this State who is required, in the performance of his official duties,
- 61 to carry firearms, and who is authorized to carry such firearms by
- 62 said commanding officer, while such civil employee is engaged in
- 63 the actual performance of his official duties; or
- 64 s. Law enforcement officers employed by governmental agencies
- 65 outside of the State of New Jersey who are engaged in their official
- 66 duties provided that they have first notified the chief law enforce-
- 67 ment officer of the municipality or the county prosecutor of the
- 68 county in which they are engaged or the superintendent.
- 69 t.. The full-time members of the marine patrol force of the
- 70 Bureau of Navigation in the Department of Conservation and
- 71 Economic Development *[having the power of arrest]* *while in
- 72 the performance of their duties*.
- 1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
