STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED MARCH 14, 1968

By Senator KAY

Referred to Committee on Revision and Amendment of Laws

AN ACT concerning crimes and supplementing chapter 111 of Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly make, issue, 1 $\mathbf{2}$ deliver, or receive dual contracts for the purchase or sale of real property. The term "dual contracts," either written or oral, means 3 2 separate contracts concerning the same parcel of real property. 4 one of which states the true and actual purchase price and one of 5 which states a purchase price in excess of the true and actual pur-6 chase price and is used to induce persons to make a loan commit-7 ment on such real property in reliance upon the stated inflated 8 value. Any person who violates the provisions of this act, is guilty 9 of a misdemeanor. 10

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
