The Assembly Military and Veterans' Affairs Committee reports favorably Assembly, No. 379.

The purpose of this bill is to honor the men and women of New Jersey who are actively serving in the United States Armed Forces, their reserve components, and the New Jersey National Guard, by establishing a permanent tribute to be displayed in the State House called "Patriots Corner." The tribute would be designed by the State House Commission, and may include a photograph and biography of each service member. The State House Commission would be responsible for obtaining the information needed for the tribute and maintaining the site.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2008-2009 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.

MINORITY STATEMENT

By Assemblymen O'Scanlon and Van Pelt

The sponsors of this bill should be commended for their efforts to honor the men and women from New Jersey who courageously serve our State and our Nation in the US Armed Forces. We strongly support the goal of this bill.

However, at this time, the State is facing very serious financial difficulties. The Governor has ordered his cabinet officers to recommend reductions in departmental spending and has directed the Treasurer to work with the Legislature to identify additional savings.

There are unanswered questions regarding the bill's monetary impact on the State. The bill contains an open-ended appropriation from the General Fund: "such amounts as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this bill". The committee did not accept our recommendation to require the State House Commission to provide the Legislature with a cost estimate prior to the establishment of the tribute.

Until such time as Governor Corzine delivers his FY2009 State budget to the Legislature, neither the members of the Legislature, nor the members of this committee, should endorse any open-ended appropriations. We are therefore compelled to withhold support for this particular legislation at this time.
