An Act concerning public utilities and amending section 48:2-23 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 48:2-23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as 2 follows:

3 48:2-23. The board may, after hearing, upon notice, by order in 4 writing, require any public utility to furnish safe, adequate and 5 proper service, including **[service]** **furnishing and per-5 formance of service in a manner** that tends to conserve and pre-6 serve the quality of the environment and prevent the pollution of 7 the waters, land and air of this State, and to maintain its property 8 and equipment in such condition as to enable it to do so.

*[2. This act shall take effect 6 months from the date of its approval, except that the Board of Public Utility Commissioners may
3 take such action as it deems necessary to assure the timely imple-

4 mentation thereof.]*

5 *2. This act shall take effect immediately.*
