P.L. 1997, CHAPTER 17, *approved January 31, 1997* Senate, No. 1399

1 AN ACT concerning the Division of Developmental Disabilities' 2 community residential and day program waiting list. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. The Legislature finds and declares that: 8 a. Between June 30, 1988 and April 30, 1996, the number of 9 persons on the Division of Developmental Disabilities' Alternate Living 10 Waiting List increased from more than 1,500 to over 4,455; b. As of April 30, 1996, nearly 900 persons had no day program 11 12 available; c. The \$80 million in bond funds available to the Division of 13 Developmental Disabilities from the Developmental Disabilities' 14 Waiting List Reduction and Human Services Facilities Construction 15 16 Fund will only deal with the capital requirements of the approximately 17 2,000 persons who are in Categories 1 and 2 of the waiting list; 18 d. The March 28, 1996 initiative announced by Governor Whitman 19 to develop community residential programs for approximately 600 developmentally disabled persons between FY 1997 and FY 1999 at 20 21 an annual cost of \$32 million will only maintain the waiting list at 22 current levels, even though the waiting list increases by one client per 23 day; 24 e. Statistics from the New Jersey Department of Education, Office 25 of Special Education Program indicate that there will be a significant increase in the number of multiply handicapped classified pupils who 26 27 will graduate from educational programs and that such pupils are likely to require community services from the Division of Developmental 28 29 Disabilities; and f. The Division of Developmental Disabilities does not have a long-30 31 term plan to eliminate the current and future waiting list and to provide for the associated capital and operational costs needed to 32 address the current and future waiting list. 33 34 35 2. a. The Commissioner of Human Services shall prepare and submit a plan to the Governor and the Legislature within 180 days 36

37 after the effective date of this act to eliminate the current and future

Division of Developmental Disabilities waiting list by the year 2008. 1 2 b. The plan shall include: 3 1. Statistical information on the current and projected increase 4 in the waiting list; 2. Financial information on the capital funds necessary to 5 6 eliminate the current and future waiting list by the year 2008; and 7 3. Financial information on the amount of additional State, 8 federal and other funds that may be required annually for operating 9 costs associated with eliminating the waiting list by the year 2008. c. In developing the plan, the commissioner shall conduct public 10 hearings and obtain public input from persons with developmental 11 disabilities or their families or guardians and providers of services to 12 13 the developmental disabilities community. d. The commissioner shall update the statistical and financial data 14 15 in the plan annually and submit the updated plan to the Governor and 16 the Legislature by December 31 of each year. 17 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 18 19 20 **STATEMENT** 21 22 23 This bill directs the Commissioner of Human Services to submit a plan for the elimination of the Division of Developmental Disabilities' 24 community residential and day program waiting lists by the year 2008 25 and to annually update the plan. 26 27 28 29 30 Requires Commissioner of Human Services to develop and submit plan 31 to eliminate developmental disabilities community residential and day 32 33 program waiting list by the year 2008.

SENATE, No. 1399

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: SEPTEMBER 19, 1996

The Senate Human Services Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 1399.

This bill directs the Commissioner of Human Services to submit a plan for the elimination of the Division of Developmental Disabilities' community residential and day program waiting lists by the year 2008 and to annually update the plan.

Specifically, the provisions of the bill require the plan to include:

- Statistical information on the current and projected increase in the waiting list;
- Financial information on the capital funds necessary to eliminate the current and future waiting list by the year 2008; and
- Financial information on the amount of additional State, federal and other funds that may be required annually for operating costs associated with eliminating the waiting list by the year 2008.

In developing the plan, the commissioner is required to conduct public hearings and obtain public input from persons with developmental disabilities or their families or guardians and providers of services to the developmental disabilities community. Also, the commissioner is required to update the statistical and financial data in the plan annually and submit the updated plan to the Governor and the Legislature by December 31 of each year.
