1 AN ACT concerning information to be maintained by the State Board  
2 of Examiners and supplementing chapter 6 of Title 18A of the New  
3 Jersey Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
6 of New Jersey:

8 1. A board of education shall notify the State Board of Examiners  
9 whenever a non-tenured, certificated employee is dismissed for cause,  
10 and the State board shall maintain a list containing the name <sup>1</sup>and  
11 Social Security number<sup>1</sup> of the employee and the reason for the  
12 dismissal for cause. A board of education or the superintendent of a  
13 school district <sup>1</sup>or the chief school administrator of a nonpublic  
14 school<sup>1</sup> may submit to the State board the name <sup>1</sup>and Social Security  
15 number<sup>1</sup> of a person who has applied for a position in the district <sup>1</sup>or  
16 nonpublic school<sup>1</sup>, and the State board shall indicate to the board or  
17 superintendent <sup>1</sup>or chief school administrator of the nonpublic school<sup>1</sup>  
18 whether the person has been previously dismissed for cause and the  
19 reason for the dismissal. This section shall not apply to a school board  
20 employee whose contract is not renewed.

21 <sup>1</sup>Any non-tenured, certificated employee who submits a false name  
22 or Social Security number to a board of education is deemed to be in  
23 violation of N.J.S.2C:28-3.<sup>1</sup>

**STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

DATED: FEBRUARY 3, 1997

The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports a Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 1170 and 1171 with committee amendments.

As amended by committee, this bill requires a board of education to notify the State Board of Examiners whenever a non-tenured, certificated employee is dismissed for cause, and requires the State board to maintain a list containing the name and Social Security number of the employee and the reason for the dismissal for cause. A board of education or the superintendent of a school district or the chief school administrator of a nonpublic school could then submit to the State board the name and Social Security number of a person who has applied for a position in the district or nonpublic school, and the State board would indicate to the board or superintendent or chief school administrator of the nonpublic school whether the person has been previously dismissed for cause and the reason for the dismissal. The provisions of the bill do not apply to a school board employee whose contract is not renewed.

The committee amended the bill to allow a nonpublic school to access the information which is kept by the State Board of Examiners on non-tenured, certificated employees and to provide that any employee who submits a false name or Social Security number to a board of education is deemed to be in violation of N.J.S.2C:28-3.

As amended by committee, this bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2518 with committee amendments.

The Senate Education Committee reports favorably a committee substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 1170 and 1171.

This committee substitute requires a board of education to notify the State Board of Examiners whenever a non-tenured, certificated employee is dismissed for cause, and requires the State board to maintain a list containing the name of the employee and the reason for the dismissal for cause. A board of education or the superintendent of a school district could then submit to the State board the name of a person who has applied for a position in the district, and the State board would indicate to the board or superintendent whether the person has been previously dismissed for cause and the reason for the dismissal. The provisions of the substitute do not apply to a school board employee whose contract is not renewed.
