## P.L. 1997, CHAPTER 243, approved September 5, 1997 Assembly, No. 1706 (Third Reprint)

1 AN ACT concerning certain notifications relating to bidding on local public contracts and amending P.L.1971, c.198.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Section 23 of P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-23) is amended to read as follows:

23. <sup>3</sup>a. Advertisements for bids; bids; general requirements. All advertisements for bids shall be published in a legal newspaper sufficiently in advance of the date fixed for receiving the bids to promote competitive bidding, but in no event less than 10 days prior to such date; except that all advertisements for bids on contracts for the collection and disposal of municipal solid waste shall be published in a legal newspaper circulating in the county or municipality, and in at least one newspaper of general circulation published in the State, sufficiently in advance of the date fixed for receiving the bids to promote competitive bidding, but not less than 60 days prior to that date.

3b. The advertisement shall designate the manner of submitting and the method of receiving the bids and the time and place at which the bids will be received. If the published specifications provide for receipt of bids by mail, those bids which are mailed to the contracting unit shall be sealed and shall only be opened for examination at such time and place as all bids received are unsealed and announced. At such time and place the contracting agent of the contracting unit shall publicly receive the bids, and thereupon immediately proceed to unseal them and publicly announce the contents, which announcement shall be made in the presence of any parties bidding or their agents, who are then and there present, and shall also make proper record of the prices

2) For all contracts for construction work, notice shall be provided no later than seven days, Saturday, Sundays, or holidays excepted, prior to the date for acceptance of bids, to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package in any of the following ways: i) in writing by certified mail or ii) by certified facsimile transmission, meaning that the sender's facsimile machine produces a receipt showing date and time of transmission and that the transmission was successful or iii) by a delivery service that provides certification of delivery to the sender.

3) For municipal solid waste collection and disposal contracts, notice shall be published in an official newspaper of the contracting unit and in at least one newspaper of general circulation published in the State no later than five days, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted, prior to the date for acceptance of bids.

d.<sup>3</sup> Failure of the contracting unit to advertise for the receipt of bids or to provide proper notification of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents related to bids as prescribed by this section shall prevent the contracting unit from accepting the bids and require the readvertisement for bids <sup>3</sup>pursuant to subsection a. of this section. Failure to obtain a receipt when good faith notice is sent or delivered to the address or telephone facsimile number on file with the contracting unit shall not be considered failure by the contracting unit to provide notice<sup>3</sup>.

At such time and place the contracting agent of the contracting unit shall publicly receive the bids, and thereupon immediately proceed to unseal them and publicly announce the contents, which announcement shall be made in the presence of any parties bidding or their agents, who are then and there present, and shall also make proper record of the prices and terms, upon the minutes of the governing body, if the award is to be made by the governing body of the contracting unit, or in a book kept for that purpose, if the award is to be made by other than the governing body, and in such latter case it shall be reported to the

governing body of the contracting unit for its action thereon, when such action thereon is required. No bids shall be received after the time designated in the advertisement.

4 Notice of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents relating to bids shall be received by any person who has submitted a 5 bid or who has received a bid package, no later than five days, 6 7 Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excepted, prior to the date for acceptance of bids[, be published in a legal newspaper and be made 8 9 available by notification in writing by certified mail to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package]. Such 10 notification shall be made in writing by certified mail, return receipt 11 12 requested, by facsimile transmission with return facsimile receipt, or 13 by next day delivery carrier; except that notice of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents relating to bids on contracts for 14 15 the collection and disposal of municipal solid waste shall be published in a legal newspaper circulating in the county or municipality, and in 16 at least one newspaper of general circulation published in the State, no 17 18 later than 5 days, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excepted, prior to 19 the date for acceptance of bids.

Failure of the contracting unit to advertise for the receipt of bids or to provide proper notification of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents related to bids as prescribed by this section shall prevent the contracting unit from accepting the bids and require the readvertisement for bids.

This bill requires that notification of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents relating to bids other than bids on contracts for the collection and disposal of municipal solid waste, be made in writing by certified mail, return receipt requested, by facsimile transmission with return facsimile receipt, or by next day delivery carrier. The bill also requires that such notification be received by any person who has submitted a bid or received a bid package not later than five days prior to the date for acceptance of bids, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excepted. Current law requires that, no later than five days prior to the date for acceptance of bids, such notification be published in a legal newspaper and be made available in writing by certified mail to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package.



The Assembly Local Government Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 1706 with committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 1706, as amended by the committee, requires that notification of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents relating to construction bids, be made in writing by certified mail, return receipt requested, by facsimile transmission with return facsimile receipt, or by next day delivery carrier. The bill, as amended by the committee, also requires that such notification be sent to any person who has submitted a bid, received a bid package, or filed a notification request, not later than seven days prior to the date for acceptance of bids, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excepted. Current law does not distinguish between construction bids and nonconstruction bids and requires that, no later than five days prior to the date for acceptance of bids, such notification be published in a legal newspaper and be made available in writing by certified mail to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package.

The committee amended the bill to remove 'the publication requirement only for construction bids and to require that notice be sent to interested parties at least seven work days prior to the date for acceptance of bids. The committee also amended the effective date of the bill to provide that it shall not take effect until the first day of the fourth month next following enactment. This will permit time for local contracting units and contractors to be made aware of the new procedure.

These amendments require that notices of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents relating to construction bids under the bill shall not increase the total cost of the contract.

# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: JANUARY 14, 1997

The Senate Community Affairs Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 1706 (2R).

This bill, as amended by the committee, would make certain changes in the requirements for notification of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents for contracts under the "Local Public Contracts Law," P.L.1971, c.198 (C.40A:11-1 et seq.).

The bill, as amended, would require that five days prior to the date for acceptance of bids, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted, notification of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents for all contracts, except those for construction work and municipal solid waste collection and disposal service, be published in an official newspaper of the contracting unit and be sent to any person who has submitted a bid or received a bid package, either in writing by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by facsimile transmission with return facsimile receipt, or by next day delivery carrier. Contracts for construction work would require the same notice, over seven instead of five days, except for that of publication in a newspaper. Contracts for solid waste collection and disposal would require only newspaper publication in two newspapers as designated by the bill.

The committee amended the bill to distinguish between the types of notice required and the types of contracts made.

Current law does not distinguish between construction bids and non-construction bids and requires that, no later than five days prior to the date for acceptance of bids, such notification be published in a legal newspaper and be made available in writing by certified mail to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package.

The effective date of the bill provides that it shall not take effect until the first day of the fourth month next following enactment, in order to permit time for local contracting units and contractors to be made aware of the new procedure.

This bill is identical to Senate Bill No. 1636 with Senate committee amendments, also reported by this committee on January 14, 1997.
