4 Any liability insurance policy subject to this section shall be
 5 construed as providing the coverage required herein, and any named
 6 insured, and any immediate family member as defined in section 14.1
 7 of P.L.1983, c.362 (C.39:6A-8.1), under that policy, shall be subject
 8 to the tort option specified in subsection a. of section 8 of P.L.1972,
 9 c.70 (C.39:6A-8).

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Sponsor's STATEMENT

25 This bill amends the statute which requires insurers authorized to
 26 transact or transacting automobile or motor vehicle insurance business
 27 in this State, or controlling or controlled by an insurer authorized to
 28 transact or transacting insurance business in this State, to provide to
 29 the out-of-state insureds who they insure for liability insurance
 30 coverage the same automobile or motor vehicle insurance coverage
 31 required of New Jersey drivers whenever the automobile or motor
 32 vehicle insured under the policy is used or operated in this State. This
 33 bill provides that, if the controlling or affiliated insurer is not
 34 transacting automobile or motor vehicle insurance business in this
 35 State, the insurers' out-of-state insureds must be provided policy
 36 coverage to satisfy at least the personal injury protection benefits
 37 coverage to any New Jersey resident who is not required to maintain
 38 personal injury protection coverage and who is not otherwise eligible
 39 for such benefits.
