P.L. 1996, CHAPTER 20, *approved April 26, 1996* Senate No. 458

1 AN ACT concerning the certification of tree experts, amending and 2 supplementing P.L.1940, c.100, and repealing parts of the statutory 3 law. 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. Section 3 of P.L.1940, c.100 (C.45:15C-3) is amended to read 9 as follows: 10 3. The Department of Environmental Protection shall establish a 11 board of tree experts consisting of three members who shall be skilled in the knowledge, science and practice of tree care and shall have been 12 13 [actively engaged as tree experts within the State of New Jersey] 14 <u>certified tree experts</u> for a period of at least [5] five years prior to 15 their selection. Members of the board shall hold office[, one for the 16 term of 1 year, one for the term of 2 years, and one] for [the] a term of [3] three years, and thereafter until their successors are appointed 17 18 by the department. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired terms 19 only. The department shall make all rules and regulations necessary 20 to carry into effect the provisions of this act. 21 (cf: P.L.1983, c.324, s.28) 22 23 2. Section 4 of P.L.1940, c.100 (C.45:15C-4) is amended to read 24 as follows: 4. The certificate of "certified tree expert" shall be granted by the 25 board [to] upon application by any natural person who is (a) a citizen 26 27 of the United States or has duly declared his or her intention of 28 becoming [such] a citizen, and [who is a legal resident of the State of New Jersey,] (b) who is over the age of 21 years, and (c) who is of 29 30 good moral character, and (d) who has graduated from a 4 year 31 college with a degree in forestry, arboriculture, ornamental 32 horticulture, landscape architecture, or the equivalent, or (e) who [shall have continuously], for at least [5] five years immediately 33 preceding the date of his application . has been [engaged in practice as 34 a tree expert, (f) who shall have successfully passed examinations in 35

Section 5 of P.L.1940, c.100 (C.45:15C-5) is amended to read 18 as follows: 19 5. New applicants who have never been certified or who have not 20 held a certificate for [3] three years previously [must] shall take an examination <u>unless the board in its discretion waives this</u> 21 22 requirement. All examinations provided for herein shall be conducted 23 by the board. The examinations shall take place as often as may be 24 necessary in the opinion of the board but not less frequently than once 25 each year. A candidate who [shall have passed a satisfactory 26 examination in all but one of the subjects given by the board of 27 examination] has taken the examination and failed any subject or 28 subjects thereof, may, at the discretion of the board, be reexamined in that subject or those subjects only, at subsequent examinations held 29 30 by the board, and if he passes in that subject or those subjects he shall 31 be considered to have passed the examination. Nothing in this [law] 32 act shall be construed as prohibiting the reexamination in all subjects 33 of a candidate who has failed any subject or subjects in a prior 34 examination. 35 (cf: P.L.1983, c.324, s.30) 36 37 4. Section 6 of P.L.1940, c.100 (C.45:15C-6) is amended to read 38 as follows: 39 6. The board of tree experts by majority vote thereof [shall] may 40 permanently revoke or temporarily suspend the effect of a certificate 41 of any certified tree expert who has been convicted of a crime in the 42 courts of this State, or has been guilty of any fraud or deceit in 43 obtaining [such] a certificate, or who has been guilty of negligence or 44 wrongful conduct in the practice of professional tree care. The board 45 may promulgate and may amend from time to time canons of professional ethics and may temporarily suspend for a period not 46

exceeding [2] two years [the effect of] the certificate of any certified 1 2 tree expert who violates [such] the canons of professional ethics, this 3 power of suspension being in addition to and not in limitation of the 4 power to revoke or suspend heretofore provided in this section. 5 Notice of [the cause for such contemplated action] and the date of hearing [thereon] of any action pursuant to this section by the board 6 7 shall be mailed to the holder of [such] the certificate at [his or her] that person's registered address at least 20 days before [said] the 8 9 hearing. No certificate issued under this act shall be revoked or [the 10 effect thereof] suspended until the board [shall have] has had [such] <u>a</u> hearing, but the nonappearance of the holder of any certificate after 11 12 notice [as herein] has been provided shall not prevent [such] the 13 hearing. By majority vote the board may reissue the certificate of any 14 certified tree expert whose certificate[shall have] has been revoked 15 and may modify [the effect of] the suspension of any certificate which 16 has been suspended. 17 (cf: P.L.1983, c.324, s.31) 18 19 5. Section 8 of P.L.1940 c.100 (C.45:15C-8) is amended to read 20 as follows: 21 8. a. No person shall represent himself or herself to the public as 22 having received a certificate as provided for in this act, or shall 23 [assume to] practice as a certified tree expert without having received [such] a certificate, and no person who, having received [such] a 24 certificate and thereafter lost the same by revocation or had [the effect 25 26 of] the [same] certificate suspended as provided for in this act, shall 27 continue to practice as a certified tree expert, and no person shall use 28 [such] the title of certified tree expert, or the abbreviation "C.T.E." or 29 any other words, letters or abbreviations tending to indicate that [such] the person is a certified tree expert without having received 30 31 [such] a certificate or if [such] their certificate has been revoked or 32 suspended. 33 b. Any person who violates this section shall be subject to a fine 34 not exceeding \$1,000. 35 (cf: P.L.1983, c.324, s.32) 36 37 6. The board may in its discretion [register the certificate of] grant 40 certification to any person who is not a resident of this State and who 41 is the lawful holder of a [C.T.E. certificate] substantially equivalent 42 certification issued under the laws of another state which extends 43 similar privileges to certified tree experts of this State; provided, the requirements [of the certificate] for certification in [the other] that 44 45 state [which has granted it to the applicant] are, in the opinion of the

The Senate Commerce Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 458.

This bill would:

a. require reappointed or newly appointed members of the board of tree experts to have been certified tree experts for at least five years;

b. allow an applicant to qualify to take the examination for certification if he has completed two years of college, passed courses in theory and practice of tree care, including botany, plant physiology, dendrology, entomology, plant pathology, and soils, and has been continuously employed in the practice of arboriculture for a period of at least three years preceding the date of his application or entry into college;

c. allow the board, in its discretion, to waive the examination requirement for new applicants and those applicants who have not held a certificate for three years;

d. allow the board to limit the subjects for reexamination to those test subjects not passed;

e. give the board discretion in the revocation or suspension of permits where such action by the board is now mandatory;

f. impose a fine of up to \$1,000 on any person who falsely represents himself as a "certified tree expert;"

g. define the title "certified tree expert" as a person who is certified pursuant to P.L. 1940, c. 100 (C. 45:15C-1 et seq.) and clearly states that the act does not restrict the right of any person to engage in the practice of arboriculture except that person may not hold himself out to be a "certified tree expert" unless certified as such;

h. establish new fees reflecting the actual costs for services provided by the board; and

i. repeal three sections of current law concerning the definition of "certified tree expert," fees and waiver of examinations.
