AN ACT concerning real estate brokers and real estate salespersons 1 2 and amending various parts of the statutory law.

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BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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1. R.S.45:15-10 is amended to read as follows:

8 45:15-10. Before any such license shall be granted the applicant, 9 and in the case of a partnership, association or corporation the 10 partners, directors or officers thereof actually engaged in the real 11 estate business as a broker, broker-salesperson or salesperson, shall 12 submit to an examination to be conducted under the supervision of the 13 commission which examination shall test the applicant's general 14 knowledge of the statutes of New Jersey concerning real property, 15 conveyancing, mortgages, agreements of sale, leases and of the provisions of this article, the rules and regulations of the commission 16 17 and such other subjects as the commission may direct. 18 commission may make rules and regulations for the conduct of such 19 examinations. Upon satisfactorily passing such examination and 20 fulfilling all other qualifications a license shall be granted by the 21 commission to the successful applicant therefor as a real estate broker, 22 broker-salesperson or salesperson, and the applicant upon receiving 23 the license is authorized to conduct in this State the business of a real estate broker, broker-salesperson or salesperson, as the case may be. 24 25 Such license shall expire on the last day of a [one-year] two-year 26 license term as established by the commission \(^1\) [which expiration date 27 shall be applicable to all licenses regardless of their date of issuance]¹; 28 such license shall be renewed, without examination, [annually] 29 biennially thereafter, upon the payment of the fee fixed by 30 R.S.45:15-15.

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2. R.S.45:15-11 is amended to read as follows:

45:15-11. Any citizen of New Jersey who has served in the armed forces of the United States or who served as a member of the American Merchant Marine during World War II and is declared by the United States Department of Defense to be eligible for federal veterans' benefits, who has been honorably discharged, and who, having been wounded or disabled in the line of duty, has completed a 40 program of courses in real estate approved by the New Jersey Real

The [annual] biennial fee for a branch office license 20 shall be \$25.00 \$50. Each license granted under this article shall 21 entitle the licensee to perform all of the acts contemplated herein 22 during the period for which the license is issued, as prescribed by this 23 article. If a licensee fails to apply for a renewal of his license prior to 24 the date of expiration of such license, the commission may refuse to 25 issue a renewal license except upon the payment of a late renewal fee in the amount of \$\[\$10.00\] \\$10 for a salesperson or broker-salesperson 26 27 and [\$20.00] \$20 for a broker; provided, however, the commission 28 may, in its discretion, refuse to renew any license upon sufficient cause 29 being shown. Renewed licenses may be granted for each 33 34 ensuing [year] two-years upon request of licensees and the payment of 35 the full fee therefor as herein required. Upon application and payment 36 of the fees provided herein, initial licenses and licenses reinstated 37 pursuant to R.S.45:15-9 may be issued, but the commission, may, in 38 its discretion, refuse to grant or reinstate any license upon sufficient 39 cause being shown. The license fees for initial or reinstated licenses 40 shall be determined based upon the [annual] biennial fees established 41 herein, with a full [annual] biennial fee payable for the license [year] 42 term in which application is received. The revocation or suspension 43 of a broker's license shall automatically suspend every real estate 44 broker-salesperson's and salesperson's license granted to employees of 45 the broker whose license has been revoked or suspended, pending a 46 change of employer and the issuance of a new license. license shall be issued without additional charge, if the same is granted during the license [year] term in which the original license was granted.

4 A real estate broker who maintains a main office or branch office 5 licensed by the commission which is located in another state shall 6 maintain a valid real estate broker's license in good standing in the 7 state where the office is located and shall maintain a real estate license 8 in that other state for each office licensed by the commission. Upon 9 request, the real estate broker shall provide a certification of his 10 license status in the other state to the commission. Any license issued 11 by the commission to a real estate broker for a main or branch office 12 located outside this State shall be automatically suspended upon the 13 revocation, suspension or refusal to renew the real estate broker's 14 license issued by the state where the office is located. The licenses 15 issued by the commission to every broker-salesperson or salesperson 16 employed by the broker shall be automatically suspended pending a 17 change of employer and the issuance of a new license. The new 18 license shall be issued without additional charge if granted during the 19 license term in which the original license was granted.

Upon request, the real estate broker shall provide a certification of his license status in the other state to the commission. Any license issued by the commission to a real estate broker for a main or branch office located outside this State shall be automatically suspended upon the revocation, suspension or refusal to renew the real estate broker's license issued by the state where the office is located. The licenses issued by the commission to every broker-salesperson or salesperson employed by the broker shall be automatically suspended pending a change of employer and the issuance of a new license. The new license shall be issued without additional charge if granted during the license term in which the original license was granted.

with Assembly Floor Amendments (Proposed By Assemblyman RUSSO)

ADOPTED: MARCH 28, 1996

These amendments allow the New Jersey Real Estate Commission to stagger the issuance and renewal dates of licenses for real estate brokers, broker-salespersons and salespersons. These amendments make this bill identical to Senate, No. 884 (1R).

The Assembly Consumer Affairs and Regulated Professions Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 1265.

This bill revises statutory law concerning the term of license for real estate brokers, broker-salespersons and salespersons. The bill changes the current one-year license term to a two-year license term for those persons who are receiving their initial licenses or are having their licenses renewed as real estate brokers, broker-salespersons or salespersons.

The bill also provides for the following biennial fees: \$100 for a real estate broker's license; \$100 for a broker-salesperson's license; \$50 for a salesperson's license; and \$50 for a branch office license. Under current law, the annual fee structures are: \$50 for a real estate broker's license; \$50 for a broker-salesperson's license; \$25 for a salesperson's license; and \$25 for a branch office license.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1996 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
