1 AN ACT concerning participation in joint insurance funds by  
2 certain non-profit organizations and amending P.L.1987, c.431.

4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the  
5 State of New Jersey:

6 1. Section 3 of P.L.1987, c.431 (C.17:49A-3) is amended to  
7 read as follows:

8 3. As used in this act:

9 a. "Board" means the board of trustees or the group of persons  
10 vested with management of the business and affairs of a  
11 nonprofit corporation regardless of the name by which the group  
12 or persons are designated.

13 b. "Keys amendment facility" means a medical or non-medical  
14 residential setting designated by the State as a facility that  
15 meets the requirements of the "Social Security Act," Pub.L.  
16 93-233 (42 U.S.C. §1382e) as implemented by 45 CFR § 1397.1 et  
17 seq.

18 c. "Nonprofit corporation" means any corporation organized  
19 under the "New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act,"  
20 N.J.S.15A:1-1 et seq., [or] any corporation as defined by  
21 N.J.S.15A:1-2e or any corporation organized pursuant to Title 16  
22 of the Revised Statutes.

23 d. "Owner" means the person or group vested with ownership  
24 and management of a Keys amendment facility regardless of the  
25 name by which the person or group is designated.

27 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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32 This bill amends current law to permit religious organizations  
33 which are incorporated under Title 16 of the Revised Statutes to  
34 participate in joint insurance funds. Adding corporations  
35 organized under Title 16 would eliminate an apparent inequity by  
36 allowing those religious organizations which have chosen not to  
37 reincorporate under Title 15A to have the same opportunities  
38 enjoyed by other religious organizations incorporated under Title  
39 15A with respect to joining together to purchase insurance or  
40 self-insurance.

The Assembly Insurance Committee reports favorably Assembly, No. 2680.

This bill amends current law to permit religious organizations which are incorporated under Title 16 of the Revised Statutes to participate in joint insurance funds. Adding corporations organized under Title 16 would eliminate an apparent inequity by allowing certain religious organizations, which have chosen not to reincorporate under Title 15A of the New Jersey Statutes, to have the same opportunities enjoyed by other religious organizations incorporated under Title 15A with respect to joining together to purchase insurance or self-insurance.

The Senate Commerce Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 2680.

This bill amends the "Nonprofit Corporation-Keys Amendment Facility Insurance Pooling Act," P.L.1987, c.431 (C.17:49A-1 et seq.), to permit religious organizations which are incorporated under Title 16 of the Revised Statutes (Corporations and Associations, Religious) to participate in joint insurance funds established under that act. Currently, nonprofit corporations organized under Title 15 of the Revised Statutes or Title 15A of the New Jersey Statutes may join together to establish joint insurance funds under that act.
