AN ACT concerning participation in joint insurance funds by certain non-profit organizations and amending P.L.1987, c.431.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. Section 3 of P.L.1987, c.431 (C.17:49A-3) is amended to read as follows:
 - 3. As used in this act:
- a. "Board" means the board of trustees or the group of persons vested with management of the business and affairs of a nonprofit corporation regardless of the name by which the group or persons are designated.
- b. "Keys amendment facility" means a medical or non-medical residential setting designated by the State as a facility that meets the requirements of the "Social Security Act," Pub.L. 93-233 (42 U.S.C. §1382e) as implemented by 45 CFR § 1397.1 et seq.
- c. "Nonprofit corporation" means any corporation organized under the "New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act," N.J.S.15A:1-1 et seq., [or] any corporation as defined by N.J.S.15A:1-2e or any corporation organized pursuant to Title 16 of the Revised Statutes.

The Senate Commerce Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 2680.

This bill amends the "Nonprofit Corporation-Keys Amendment Facility Insurance Pooling Act," P.L.1987, c.431 (C.17:49A-1 et seq.), to permit religious organizations which are incorporated under Title 16 of the Revised Statutes (Corporations and Associations, Religious) to participate in joint insurance funds established under that act. Currently, nonprofit corporations organized under Title 15 of the Revised Statutes or Title 15A of the New Jersey Statutes may join together to establish joint insurance funds under that act.
