AN ACT concerning dam repairs, amending R.S.58:4-1 and supplementing P.L. 1969, c. 19 (C.58:16A-50 et al.).

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. R.S.58:4-1 is amended to read as follows:

58:4-1. a. No municipality, corporation or person shall. without the consent of the Commissioner of Environmental Protection, hereafter in this chapter designated as the commissioner, build any reservoir or construct any dam on any river or stream in this State or between this and any other such state which will raise the waters of such river or stream more than five feet above their usual mean low-water height, nor repair, alter or improve existing dams which so raise the water. without such consent, but this shall not affect or relate to a dam or reservoir in the pinelands area, as designated by subsection a. of section 10 of P.L.1979, c.111 (C.13:18A-11), which will raise the waters of any river or stream less than eight feet above the surface of the ground where the drainage area above the same is less than one square mile in extent and where the water surface created by the dam or reservoir is less than 100 acres in extent, except that the commissioner may investigate and take appropriate action regarding any dam or reservoir about which he has a security or safety concern. With respect to dams and reservoirs located on lands utilized for agricultural or horticultural purposes within the pinelands area, the commissioner's actions shall be undertaken after consultation with the Secretary of Agriculture.

b. The commissioner shall not require a permit for the repair of any dam located on lands used for horticultural or agricultural purposes within the pinelands area.

The Senate Senior Citizens, Veterans Affairs and Agriculture Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 2306 with committee amendments.

This bill, as amended, would amend the dam construction provisions of chapter 4 of Title 58 of the Revised Statutes and supplement the "Flood Hazard Area Control Act," P.L.1962, c.19 [58:16A-50 et al.] to prohibit the Commissioner of Environmental Protection from requiring a permit for the repair of any dam used for agricultural purposes in areas of the pinelands that are designated special agricultural production areas.

The committee amended the bill to limit its provisions to dams used for agricultural purposes within areas of the pinelands that are designated special agricultural production areas pursuant to N.J.A.C.7:50-6.14. The amendments would also clarify the language in the existing law with regard to permit requirements for all other dams, without making substantive changes.

The Assembly Appropriations Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2306 (1R).

Senate Bill No. 2306 (1R) amends the dam construction provisions of chapter 4 of Title 58 of the Revised Statutes and supplement the "Flood Hazard Area Control Act," P.L. 1962, c. 19 (58:16A-80 et al.) to prohibit the Commissioner of Environmental Protection from requiring a permit for the repair of a dam used for agricultural purposes in areas of the pinelands that are designated special agricultural production areas.

As reported by this committee, this bill is identical to A-3290 as reported by this committee.

#### **PISCAL IMPACT:**

This bill was not certified as requiring a fiscal note. The bill affects the regulation and timing of repairs to Jame used for agricultural purposes in areas of the pinelands that are designated special agricultural production areas, and does not impact State revenues.
