As used in this act: 8 9 "Biotechnology" means any technique that uses living 10 organisms, or parts of living organisms, to make or modify 11 products, to improve plants or animals, or to develop micro-organisms for specific uses; including the industrial use of 12 recombinant DNA, cell fusion, and novel bioprocessing techniques. 13 "Local agency" means a county or municipality, and includes a 14 local health board or other local subdivision. 15 "State agency" means each of the principal departments in the 16 Executive Branch of the State Government, and all boards, 17 18 commissions, agencies, departments, divisions. councils, 19 authorities, offices or officers within any such departments now 20 existing or hereafter established. 2. a. When federal law or regulation requires the submission 21 22 of biotechnology trade secrets and related confidential 23 information. State and local agencies shall not have access to this information except as allowed by federal law. 24 25 b.
