AN ACT prohibiting loce? regulation of biotechnology and supplementing chapter 48 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. As used in this act:

"Biotechnology" means ¹[any technique that uses living organisms, or parts of living organisms, to make or modify products, to improve plants or animals, or to develop micro-organisms for specific uses; including the industrial use of recombinant DNA, cell fusion, and novel bioprocessing techniques! the continually expanding body of fundamental knowledge about the functioning of biological systems from the macro level to the molecular and sub-atomic levels, as well as novel products, services, technologies and sub-technologies developed as a result of insights gained from research advances which add to that body of fundamental knowledge¹.

- 2. a. A county, municipality, including a local health board, or other local subdivision ¹[,]¹ shall not regulate the development of biotechnology or the use of materials and organisms created through the application of biotechnology.
- b. This act shall not affect the powers of a county, municipality, including a local health board, or other local subdivision $^1[,]^1$ to otherwise regulate business, industry, construction, and public utilities, or to provide fire protection and other public safety services.
 - 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Prohibits local regulation of biotechnology.

The Senate Natural Resources, Trade and Economic Development Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 711, with Senate committee amendments.

This bill prohibits any regulation by counties, municipalities, local health boards, or other local subdivisions of the development of biotechnology and the use of materials and organisms created through the application of biotechnology.

The bill does not affect any existing authority of counties, municipalities, local health boards, or other local subdivisions, to otherwise regulate business, industry, construction, and public utilities, or to provide fire protection and other public safety services.

The committee amended the bill to change the definition of "biotechnology," which has been made broader. This amendment makes the definition identical to the definition used in Senate Bill No. 884 and Senate Bill No. 812, as those bills were amended by the committee. Other technical amendments are grammatical in nature.
