1 AN ACT concerning the use of school buses and supplementing
2 chapter 39 of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the*
5 *State of New Jersey:*

6 1. The board of education of a school district may, pursuant to
7 rules adopted by it, permit the use of school buses owned ¹[or] ¹
8 leased ¹or contracted¹ by the school district for the purpose of
9 transporting a handicapped adult who is ²a client of the Division
10 of Developmental Disabilities in the Department of Human
11 Services and who is² continuing his education and training
12 following graduation from secondary school. Transportation
13 pursuant to this section will be limited to space availability on
14 vehicles engaged in the transportation of school-age pupils along
15 established routes. The board shall require that the individual
16 transported, or his parent or guardian, pay all or part of any costs
17 incurred by the district in providing the transportation, including
18 but not limited to, the costs of fuel, driver salaries, insurance and
19 depreciation.

20 ¹[In the event the school district contracts for transportation
21 services, the provisions of this section shall apply to
22 transportation by the carrier, and the individual transported, or
23 his parent or guardian, shall reimburse the carrier for the costs of
24 the transportation.]¹

25 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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30 Permits the use of school buses for the transportation of a

The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1102.

This bill authorizes school districts to provide transportation to handicapped adults who are furthering their education or training following graduation from secondary school. The transportation will be limited to a space available basis on school buses transporting school-age pupils along established routes. The bill requires the handicapped individual or his parent or guardian to pay the costs of the transportation.

This bill was introduced in the 1994-95 legislative session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.

The Senate Education Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1102 (1R).

This bill authorizes school districts to provide transportation to handicapped adults who are furthering their education or training. The transportation will be limited to a space availability basis on school buses transporting school-age pupils along established routes. The costs of transporting the handicapped adult will be paid all or in part by the handicapped individual or his parent or guardian.

As reported, this bill is identical to S-738 with Senate committee amendments.
