1993 Senate No. 1579

1 AN ACT concerning the dates for the evaluation and notification 2 of nontenured teaching staff members and amending P.L.1975, 3 c.132 and P.L.1971, c.436. 4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the 5 6 State of New Jersev: 7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1975, c.132 (C.18A:27-3.1) is amended to 8 read as follows: 1. Every board of education in this State shall cause each 9 10 nontenure teaching staff member employed by it to be observed and evaluated in the performance of her or his duties at least 11 12 three times during each school year but not less than once during 13 each semester. Said evaluations are to take place before [May 16] 14 April 30 each year. The evaluations may cover that period between [May 16] April 30 of one year and [May 16] April 30 of 15 the succeeding year excepting in the case of the first year of 16 17 employment where the three evaluations must have been completed prior to [May 16] April 30. The number of required 18 observations and evaluations may be reduced proportionately 19 20 when an individual teaching staff member's term of service is 21 less than one academic year. Each evaluation shall be followed 22 by a conference between that teaching staff member and his or 23 her superior or superiors. The purpose of this procedure is to 24 recommend as to reemployment, identify any deficiencies, extend 25 assistance for their correction and improve professional 26 competence. This act shall take effect immediately. 41 42 STATEMENT 43 44 This bill changes the date for completing the evaluation of 45 nontenured teaching staff members from before May 16 to before 46 April 30, and the date for the notification of employment of 47 those members from on or before May 31 to on or before May 15. 48 Under the current statutes, a nontenured teaching staff member 49 must notify the board of education on or before June 1 that the 50 member has accepted an offer of employment.

The Assembly Education Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 1579.

This bill changes the time period for completing the evaluation of nontenured teaching staff members from before May 16 to before April 30, and the time period for the notification of employment of those members from on or before May 31 to on or before May 15.

Under current law, a nontenured teaching staff member must notify the board of education on or before June 1 that the member has accepted an offer of employment.

This bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2336 of 1992.
