P.L.1993, CHAPTER 302, approved December 23, 1993  
1993 Senate No. 1552

1 AN ACT to establish the New Jersey Council of County  
2 Vocational Schools and supplementing chapter 54 of Title 18A  
3 of the New Jersey Statutes.

4  
5 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the  
6 State of New Jersey:

7 1. There is established a body corporate and politic, with  
8 corporate succession, to be known as the New Jersey Council of  
9 County Vocational Schools. A county vocational school  
10 established pursuant to chapter 54 of Title 18A of the New Jersey  
11 Statutes may, upon the approval of its board of education, be a  
12 member of the council.

13 2. The council shall consist of the president of the board of  
14 education and the superintendent of each county vocational  
15 school which is a member of the council. A board of education  
16 president may designate another member of the board as an  
17 alternate to attend and to vote at council meetings in the  
18 president's absence. A member of the council shall serve  
19 without compensation but may be reimbursed for all reasonable  
20 and necessary expenses.

21 3. The council shall select such officers and make such rules  
22 and regulations as may be necessary for the transaction of  
23 business. The council may, if it deems necessary, impose and  
24 collect dues from council members to defray expenses. The  
25 council may also employ such staff as it determines is necessary  
26 within the limit of funds available for this purpose.

27 4. The council shall have perpetual succession and shall have  
28 the following powers and duties:

29 a. To make, amend and repeal rules, regulations and bylaws for  
30 its own government and guidance, not inconsistent with the  
31 purposes of the council;

32 b. To adopt an official seal and alter the same at pleasure;

33 c. To maintain an office at such place or places in the State as  
34 it may designate;

35 d. To sue and be sued in its own name;

36 e. To acquire, hold and dispose of real and personal property in  
37 the exercise of its powers and the performance of its duties under  
38 this act. All this property shall be exempt from taxation under  
39 chapter 4 of Title 54 of the Revised Statutes; and

40 f. To aid all initiatives for the improvement of vocational,  
41 technical, and occupational education and to make  
42 recommendations to the State Board of Education concerning the  
43 county vocational schools.

44 5. This act shall take effect immediately.

The Senate Education Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 1552 without committee amendments.

This bill establishes the New Jersey Council of County Vocational Schools and provides that a county vocational school, upon the approval of its board of education, may be a member of the council. The council is to consist of the president of the board of education and the superintendent of each county vocational school which chooses to be a member of the council.

The council is charged with aiding all initiatives for the improvement of vocational, technical, and occupational education and to make recommendations to the State Board of Education concerning the county vocational schools.

Under the bill's provisions, the council is authorized to select officers, impose and collect dues from council members as may be necessary to defray expenses, and to employ such staff as it determines is necessary within the limit of available funds.
