INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 24, 1992

By Assemblyman SOSA

AN ACT concerning the waiver of building restrictions imposed on certain public or private sales and amending P.L.1943, c.33.

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BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. Section 1 of P.L.1943, c.33 (C.40:60-51.2) is amended to read as follows:
- Any municipality is authorized and empowered, by resolution of the governing body thereof, to waive, release, modify or subordinate any terms, covenants, conditions, limitations or reverters imposed in sales and conveyances of lands as to the erection, alteration or demolition of buildings or any other use to be made of land heretofore imposed by said municipality to accomplish the purposes for which such lands were sold and conveyed either at public or private sale made prior to January 1, [1979] 1[1989] 1990, but only after public hearing held before such governing body, of the holding of which notice describing the lands in question, and the terms, covenants, conditions, limitations or reverters to be waived, released, modified or subordinated, and, if to be modified or subordinated, describing the manner in which the same shall be modified or subordinated, shall first have been given by advertisement published once each week for 2 weeks in a newspaper published in said municipality or, if no newspaper be published therein, then in a newspaper circulating in such municipality, provided, however, that the power herein granted shall not be exercised to impair any vested or contractual rights of third parties.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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Permits municipal governing body to waive building restrictions on sale of certain lands.

The Assembly Local Government Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 977, with Assembly committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 977, as amended by the committee, would amend section 1 of P.L.1943, c.33 (C.40:60-51.2) to permit the governing body of a municipality, by resolution, to waive, release, modify or subordinate building restrictions imposed at the time of the public or private sale of lands made prior to January 1, 1990. The waiver would occur only after a public hearing, held after advertisement, published once a week for two weeks, in a newspaper published or circulating in the municipality.

This statute was last amended in 1983, when the date for the modification of restrictions was changed from January 1, 1976 to January 1, 1979. The committee's amendments change that date from January 1, 1989 to January 1, 1990.

The Senate Community Affairs Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 977 (1R).
