1 AN ACT concerning interest assessed on late charges due to the 2 Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission and amending P.L.1953, 3 c.388.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the 6 State of New Jersey:

1. Section 11 of P.L.1953, c.388 (C.58:14-34.20) is amended to 7 8 read as follows:

11. For all purposes of the original act, and of any contract 9 10 made or hereafter made thereunder or for the purposes thereof, the cost and expense of maintenance, repair and operation of the 11 sewerage system for any year shall be deemed to include, and 12 13 shall include, in addition to all other items heretofore included, all interest becoming due prior to the end of such year on bonds 14 or other obligations of the commissioners issued pursuant to this 15 act, plus the principal or redemption premium of any such bonds 16 or obligations becoming due prior to the end of such year, plus 17 18 such sums as the commissioners may determine or by the terms of any contract be required to set aside during such year as a 19 20 reserve for payment or security of principal of or interest on any 21 such bonds or obligations or be by the terms of any contract 22 required to set aside during such year as a reserve for any other purpose. The contracting municipalities and other users of the 23 24 sewerage system are hereby authorized and directed to do and perform any and all acts and things necessary, convenient or 25 desirable to pay to the commissioners annually the total cost and 26 expense (as herein referred to and described) of maintenance, 27 repair and operation of the sewerage system apportioned as above 28 provided. If any payment on account of the cost and expense (as 2930 herein referred to and described) of maintenance, repair and operation of the sewerage system, or any part thereof, due to the 31 32 commissioners under the original act or any such contract from a 33 contracting municipality or other user shall remain unpaid for 30 days after the commissioners have notified such contracting 34 municipality or other user by mail of the amount due and the due 35 date, such contracting municipality or other user shall be charged 36 with and shall pay to the commissioners interest on the amount 37 unpaid from 30 days after such notice of the commissioners was 38 mailed until paid, at [the] a rate [of] equal to ³two percentage 39 40 points over³ the average prime rate for the 30-day period beginning on the date the notice of the commissioners was 41 42 mailed³[, but not in excess of 12% per annum]³. The Assembly Local Government Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1252 with Assembly committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 1252, as amended by the committee, establishes that the interest to be assessed on late charges due to the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission will be equal to the average prime rate for the 30-day period beginning on the date on which the commissioners give notice of the amount due and the due date, but will not exceed 12% per annum.

Under current law, the interest rate is 12% per annum.

The committee amended the bill to insert a new section requiring that within 30 days from the effective date of the bill, the rate of interest on late charges that were assessed prior to that date but payable after that date be recalculated pursuant to the provisions of this bill.

with Senate committee amendments

The Senate Community Affairs Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1252 [1R] with Senate committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 1252 [1R], as amended by the committee, establishes that the interest to be assessed on late charges due to the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission will be equal to the average prime rate for the 30-day period beginning on the date on which the commissioners give notice of the amount due and the due date, but will not exceed 12% per annum.

Under current law, the interest rate is 12% per annum.

The bill also establishes that the new calculation of the late interest charge shall be applied to any unpaid late charges which were assessed prior to the effective date of this act.

Upon referral to this committee, the recalculation was to apply to late charges assessed prior to the effective date of the act, but payable afterwards.
