The Senate Community Affairs Committee favorably reports a Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 671, 766 and Assembly Bill No. 1008.

The Senate Committee Substitute would extend the current exemption from local rent controls for newly constructed multiple dwellings which is due to expire on June 25, 1992.

P.L.1987, c.153 (C.2A:42-84.1 et seq.) instituted an "experimental program" to encourage greater production of rental housing by exempting newly constructed multiple dwellings from local rent controls. The program was intended to run for five years, and the law is due to expire on June 25, 1992. This bill would extend the expiration date to June 25, 1997.
