This bill permits the governing bodies of counties and municipalities to appropriate funds, on an annual basis, in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation to aid in the development, construction and maintenance of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center in Holmdel.

The bill is retroactive to January 1, 1990.

The Senate Community Affairs Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 44 with Senate committee amendments.

Senate Bill No. 44, as amended by the committee, permits the governing bodies of counties and municipalities to annually appropriate funds in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation in support of the development, construction and maintenance of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center.

The committee amended the bill to provide that any appropriation made by a county or municipality to support the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial should be made to the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation. The committee also amended the bill to make it retroactive to January 1, 1990.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1992 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
