7 18A:19-3. All claims and demands, exceeding ~~[\$25.00]~~ \$150.00
8 in amount, except for payrolls and debt service, shall be verified
9 by affidavit, or by a signed declaration in writing, contained
10 therein or annexed thereto, to the effect that the same are
11 correct in all particulars, that the articles have been furnished or
12 the services rendered as stated therein and that no bonus has
13 been given or received on account thereof.

The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports this bill without committee amendments.

This bill removes the affidavit or declaration requirement on purchases by school districts of services or articles costing less than \$150.00. At present, the law requires that claims exceeding \$25.00 be verified by an affidavit or signed declaration stating that the articles have been furnished or the services rendered and that no bonus has been given or received.

This bill is intended to simplify the payment procedures for articles and services costing less than \$150.00 so that vendors can be paid by school districts in a timely manner.

During the committee meeting, the New Jersey School Boards Association and the New Jersey Association of School Business Officials indicated support for the bill.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
