AN ACT concerning the verification of claims by school districts and amending N.J.S.18A:19-3.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

N.J.S.18A:19-3 is amended to read as follows:

18A:19-3. All claims and demands, exceeding [\$25.00] \$150.00 in amount, except for payrolls and debt service, shall be verified by affidavit, or by a signed declaration in writing, contained therein or annexed thereto, to the effect that the same are correct in all particulars, that the articles have been furnished or the services rendered as stated therein and that no bonus has been given or received on account thereof.

This bill removes the affidavit or declaration requirement on purchases by school districts of services or articles costing less than \$150.00.
