1 AN ACT concerning license and examination fees for
2 convalescent and nursing home administrators and amending
3 P.L.1968, c.356.

5 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the*
6 *State of New Jersey:*

7 1. Section 3 of P.L.1968, c.356 (C.30:11-13) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 3. Upon receipt of an application for license and a license fee
10 of [~~\$100.00~~] \$100, and an examination fee of [~~\$75.00~~] \$100, the
11 department shall cause an investigation to be made of the
12 applicant and shall issue a license if it is found that said applicant
13 is of good moral character and complies with the provisions of
14 this act, the regulations of the department and the minimum
15 standards established for the administration of a convalescent
16 home or private nursing home. The license shall not be
17 transferable or assignable and shall be posted in a conspicuous
18 place on the licensed premises wherein the individual acts as an
19 administrator, as prescribed by the regulations of the
20 department. The [State Department] Commissioner of Health,
21 with the advice of the Nursing Home Administrators' Licensing
22 Board, shall adopt, amend, promulgate and enforce such rules,
23 regulations, and minimum standards for the training, experience
24 and education of individuals acting as administrators of
25 convalescent homes and private nursing homes to be licensed
26 hereunder as may be reasonably necessary to accomplish the
27 purposes of this chapter. In addition, the commissioner shall
28 adopt rules and regulations to provide for such periodic increases
29 in the license fee and the examination fee as the commissioner
30 deems necessary. Such rules, regulations and minimum standards
31 when adopted shall be binding upon all licensees and applicants
32 for a license under this chapter. Licensees and applicants for a
33 license as a convalescent home or private nursing home
34 administrator of an institution or home conducted exclusively for
35 persons who rely upon treatment by spiritual means alone through
36 prayer in accordance with the creed or tenets of a recognized
37 church or religious denomination as described in section 9 of
38 P.L.1947, c.340 (C.30:11-9) shall meet all rules, regulations, and

with Assembly committee amendments

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: OCTOBER 15, 1990

The Assembly Health and Human Services Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 3469 with committee amendments.

As amended by the committee, this bill increases the examination fee for convalescent and nursing home administrators from \$75 to \$100 and gives the Commissioner of Health the authority to increase this fee and the license fee by regulation on a periodic basis as the commissioner deems necessary.

The convalescent and nursing home administrators examination is the property of the National Association of Boards of Examiners for Nursing Home Administrators, which proposed an increase in the examination fee for association members from \$75 to \$100, that took effect on July 1, 1990. The Department of Health is a member of the association, and this bill will conform the examination fee in New Jersey with that of the association.

The committee adopted a technical amendment to provide that the bill shall take effect immediately upon enactment. The bill, as introduced, would have taken effect immediately or on July 1, 1990, whichever date was later.
