The Assembly Municipal Government Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1642 with Assembly committee amendments.

This bill changes the title of "municipal court clerk" to "municipal court administrator" to reflect the professionalization of the duties of the position from generally clerical to both clerical and administrative. The committee amended the bill to substitute the term "municipal court clerk-administrator" with "municipal court administrator."

This bill has been pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
