The Assembly County Government Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 341 (1R).

Senate Bill No. 341 (1R) authorizes the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles in the Department of Law and Public Safety to issue special license plates for vehicles which are leased by county officials. Current law authorizes the special plates only for vehicles owned by these officials.

The fee for these special plates is $\$ 15.00$, in addition to any other fees required by law for the registration of motor vehicles.

Senate Bill No. 341 also clarifies language concerning the applications for such plates, and shortens from 60 to 30 days the time within which the plates must be returned to the division after the person to whom they were issued leaves office.

#### Abstract

The Senate Law, Public Safety and Defense Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 341 with amendments.

As amended, this bill authorizes the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles in the Department of Law and Public Safety to issue special license plates for vehicles which are leased by county officials. Current law authorizes the special plates only for vehicles owned by these officials.

The fee for these special plates is $\$ 15.00$ in addition to any other fees required by law for the registration of motor vehicles.

The committee amended the bill to clarify language concerning the applications for such plates and to shorten from 60 to 30 days the time within the plates must be returned to the division after the person to whom they were issued leaves office.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
