The Assembly Veterans and Military Affairs Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 1816 [1R].

This bill designates July 27 of each year as "Korean War Veterans' Day" in recognition of the courage and unwavering patriotism of those men and women of this State who served in the armed forces of the United States during the Korean War.

The bill provides that the Governor shall issue annually a proclamation designating this day as "Korean War Veterans' Day" and with the Legislature call upon the citizens of this State to recognize this day with appropriate observances.

The Senate Senior Citizen and Veteran Affairs Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 1816 with Senate committee amendments.

This bill, as amended, designates July 27 of each year as "Korean War Veterans' Day" in recognition of the courage and unwavering patriotism of those men and women of this State who served in the armed forces during the Korean War.

The committee amended the bill to recognize those veterans of the Korean War who are still carried on the rolls as missing in action.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
