BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. A person who is an active member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart may affix a purple heart emblem which has been approved by the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to a licence plate issued for a motor vehicle owned or leased by that member.

2. The Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles shall promulgate rules and regulations governing the use, design, materials and placement of purple heart emblems on license plates issued for motor vehicles owned or leased by active members of the Military Order of the Purple Heart

3. This act shall take effect 60 days after enactment, except that section 2 shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill permits active members of the Military Order of the Purple Heart to affix purple heart emblems on license plates of their motor vehicles. The bill also requires the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to promulgate rules for the use and placement of the emblems. Presumably, the members would be responsible for providing the emblems at their own expense, pursuant to the State regulations.

MOTOR VEHICLES

The Assembly Veterans and Military Affairs Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 3084.

This bill permits active members of the Military Order of the Purple Heart (MOPH) to affix purple heart emblems on the license plates of their motor vehicles in accordance with the regulations to be promulgated by the Division of Motor Vehicles for the use, design, material and placement of the emblems. The bill does not require the State to make the emblems available to members of the MOPH. Therefore, those members wishing to display the emblems must secure them at their own expense. .
