PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1990 SESSION

By Senator EWING

1 AN ACT concerning the filing of certain documents with the
2 Joint Legislative Committee on Ethical Standards and
3 supplementing Title 52 of the Revision Statutes.

5 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the*
6 *State of New Jersey:*

7 1. As used in this act, "document" means any statement,
8 report, form, or accounting which is required to be filed with
9 the Joint Legislative Committee on Ethical Standards within a
10 prescribed period or on or before a prescribed date pursuant to
11 law or the legislative code of ethics promulgated pursuant to the
12 "New Jersey Conflicts of Interest Law," P.L.1971, c.182
13 (C.52:13D-12 et seq.). The term "within a prescribed period or
14 on or before a prescribed date" includes any extension of time
15 granted by the committee for filing a document.

16 2. Any document which is mailed shall be deemed to be
17 timely filed if the postmark stamped on the cover, envelope or
18 wrapper in which the document was mailed bears a date on or
19 before the date of the last day prescribed for filing the
20 document.

21 3. When the date or the last day prescribed for filing a
22 document falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the next
23 succeeding business day shall be regarded as the date of the last
24 day prescribed for filing the document.

25 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

30 This bill provides that any mandatory document, statement,
31 report, form or accounting filed with the Joint Legislative
32 Committee on Ethical Standards shall be considered timely filed
33 if it bears a postmark date on or before the date of the last day
34 prescribed for filing the document.
