AN ACT concerning temporary permits for the sale of alcoholic beverages and amending R.S.33:1-74.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. R.S.33:1-74 is amended to read as follows:

7 33:1-74. a. To provide for contingencies where it would be 8 appropriate and consonant with the spirit of this chapter to issue 9 a license but the contingency has not been expressly provided for, the director of the division may for special cause shown, subject 10 to rules and regulations, issue temporary permits. The fee for a 11 one-day permit authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages for 12 consumption on a designated premises by <u>a</u> civic, religious $1[or]_1$ 13 educational ¹[organization]¹ or ¹[by a]¹ veterans organization 14 shall be \$50.00 and for a one-day permit authorizing such sale by 15 any other organization, \$75.00. The fee for any other type of 16 temporary permit shall be determined in each case by the 17 18 director of the division and shall not be less than \$5.00 nor more than \$500.00, payable to the director of the division and to be 19 20 accounted for by him as are license fees.

21 b. As to any designated premises such temporary permits shall not exceed in the aggregate 25 in any one calendar year, but the 22 23 director of the division may by said rules and regulations provide for a lesser number in the aggregate for any such designated 24 25 premises in any one calendar year.

c. The issuance of temporary permits to authorize the sale of 26 alcoholic beverages by the glass or other open receptacle by 27 civic, religious, educational 1, veterans 1 or other qualified 28 organizations shall be permissible, nothwithstanding that the sale 29 of alcoholic beverages has otherwise been prohibited by 30 referendum under R.S.33:1-44 through R.S.33:1-47 or municipal 31 32 ordinance or resolution.

To provide for contingencies where it would be 7 appropriate and consonant with the spirit of this chapter to issue 8 a license but the contingency has not been expressly provided for, 9 the director of the division may for special cause shown, subject 10 to rules and regulations, issue temporary permits. The fee for a 11 one-day permit authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages for 12 consumption on a designated premises by a civic, religious or 13 educational organization or by a veterans organization shall be 14 \$50.00 and for a one-day permit authorizing such sale by any 15 other organization, \$75.00. The fee for any other type of 16 temporary permit shall be determined in each case by the 17 director of the division and shall not be less than \$5.00 nor more 18 19 than \$500.00, payable to the director of the division and to be 20 accounted for by him as are license fees.

b. As to any designated premises such temporary permits shall 21 not exceed in the aggregate 25 in any one calendar year, but the 22 23 director of the division may by said rules and regulations provide for a lesser number in the aggregate for any such designated 24 25 premises in any one calendar year.

c. The issuance of temporary permits to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages by the glass or other open receptacle by civic, religious, educational or other qualified organizations shall be permissible, nothwithstanding that the sale of alcoholic 29 beverages has otherwise been prohibited by referendum under 30 31 R.S.33:1-44 through R.S.33:1-47 or municipal ordinance or resolution. 32

The Assembly Veterans and Military Affairs Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 1749 (1R).

This bill provides that the fee to be paid to the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control by a veterans organization for a one-day permit to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on a designated premises would be \$50, rather than the \$75 currently charged. Under current law, civic, religious and educational organizations are charged \$50.

The Senate Law, Public Safety and Defense Committee reports favorably Senate Bill 1749 with amendments.

As amended, this bill provides that the fee to be paid to the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control by a veterans organization for a one-day permit to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on a designated premises would be \$50, rather than the \$75 currently charged. Civic, religious, and educational organizations are charged \$50.

The committee amended the bill to clarify its wording.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
