ACT concerning the experience requirements for a AN cortificato as a cortified public accountant and amending P.L. 1977, c. 144.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General A sembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Section 8 of P.L. 1977, c. 144 (C.45:2B-8) is amended to read as follows:

8. Every applicant for a certificate shall present to the board 4 a written application for such certificate on a form to be 10 11 provided by the board, together with the required fee, and satisfactory proof of the following:

a. That the applicant is at least 18 years of age;

b. That the applicant is of good moral character; and

c. That the applicant is a resident of this State or maintains an office in this State for the regular practice of public accounting 16 or is employed in this State by a certified public accountant or 18 firm of certified public accountants having an office in this State for the practice of public accounting; 19

d. That the applicant has a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent as determined by the New Jersey Department of Higher Education including such courses in accounting and related 23professional courses as the board may require, provided, that the 24 board shall admit to the examination an individual who demonstrates to the board's satisfaction that he has acquired 25 26 through experience and substantial formal higher education the equivalent of such baccalaureate degree; 27

e. That the applicant has had in the aggregate the following experience:

(1) At least 2 years in public accounting work in the office of a certified public accountant or a public accountant, or a firm of certified public accountants or a firm of public accountants; or

(2) [At least 4 years in the general practice of public accounting; or] (Deleted by amendment, P.L...., c....).

(3) At least 4 years accounting work in the employ of some state or any political subdivision thereof or of the United States; OL

(4) At least 4 years in comparable accounting activity.

EXPLANATION--Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

Matter underlined thus is new matter.

The board may accept teaching experience or graduate or other study in courses related to accounting in lieu of the required experience.

Evidence of such experience or study shall be submitted to the board in detail for its review and evaluation. Such evidence must demonstrate preparation for practice requiring the intensive, 1 diversified application of accounting and auditing principles and procedures. 8

9 The board may accept service in the Armed Forces of the 10 United States for experience credit on the basis of 1 month's credit for each 6 months' service, with a maximum credit of 8 11 12 months.

Currently, an individual who works for a certified 22 public accountant or a firm of certified public accountants is only required to have two years of experience prior to taking the 23 24 examination, while an individual who works for a public accountant or a firm of public accountants must have four years 25of experience. This bill will revise the statute so that an 26 individual who works for a public accountant or a firm of public 27 accountants shall only be required to have two years of 28 experience in order to be eligible to take the examination. 29

The Assembly Commerce and Regulated Professions Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 1960.

This bill amends the "Public Accounting Act of 1977," P.L.1977, c.144 (C.45:2B-1 et seq.) to revise the experience requirement necessary to sit for the examination for a certificate as a certified public accountant. Currently, an individual who works for a certified public accountant or a firm of certified public accountants is only required to have two years of experience prior to taking the examination, while an individual who works for a public accountant or a firm of public accountants must have four years of experience. This bill revises the statute so that an individual who works for a public accountant or a firm of public accountants shall only be required to have two years of experience in order to be eligible to take the examination.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1990 session pending technical review. As reported the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
