PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1969 SESSION

AN ACT concerning ****[enforcement]**** ****security**** officers in certain municipalities and supplementing Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. In any city of the first class, the governing body may create
2 the title of ****[enforcement]**** ****security**** officers under the
3 classified service of civil service, and may appoint and commission
4 as many ****[enforcement]**** ****security**** officers as it may deem neces-
5 sary to patrol the grounds, buildings and other areas and facilities
6 of all schools ****[and other public properties of such municipal-**
7 **ity]****, *libraries, museums, hospitals, housing projects, municipal*
8 *parks and municipal buildings, owned or leased by such munici-*
9 *pality.** The municipality shall organize such ****[enforcement]****
10 ****security**** officers into a separate division or unit of its police
11 department, and they shall have all the powers conferred by law
12 on police officers or constables in the enforcement of the laws of
13 this State, and the apprehension of offenders. *****Security officers**
14 *shall be subject to and receive training in the same manner as other*
15 *members of the municipal police force.****

1 2. Those individuals who are employed in cities of the first class
2 under the title of housing guard or housing patrolman **that have*
3 *been appointed in accordance with Title 11, Civil Service** on the
3A effective date of this act shall be eligible for appointment under the
4 title of ****[enforcement]**** ****security**** officer and shall be so cer-
5 tified to the Civil Service Commission without the requirement of a
6 civil service examination. Such persons shall, from the effective
7 date of this act, hold their positions or employments subject to and
8 in accordance with the provisions of Title 11, Civil Service, of the
9 Revised Statutes.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
