AN ACT authorizing village presidents to solemnize marriages and amending section 37:1-13 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 37:1-13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 37:1-13. Each judge of a County Court, judge of a county district court,  
3 or magistrate of a municipal court, and mayor or village president of this  
4 State, and every minister of every religion, and judges of the criminal judi-  
5 cial district courts in counties wherein such courts are or may be established,  
6 and judges of the juvenile and domestic relations courts in counties in which  
7 such courts are or may be established, are hereby authorized to solemnize  
8 marriage between such persons as may lawfully enter into the matrimonial  
9 relation; and every religious society, institution or organization in this State  
10 may join together in marriage such persons as are members of such society,  
11 institution or organization, or when one of such persons is a member of such  
12 society, institution or organization, according to the rules and customs of the  
13 society, institution or organization to which they or either of them belong.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
