AN ACT requiring certificates of ownership of motor vehicles used
as police patrol cars to indicate such use on said certificate and
supplementing chapter 10 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. In every sale or transfer of a used motor vehicle which has
2 been used as a police patrol car, whether said patrol car bore mark-
3 ings identifying it as such or not, the certificate of ownership shall
4 state that said motor vehicle was used as a police patrol car, and
5 shall continue to so state on each subsequent sale or transfer.

1 2. Any person who transfers or attempts to transfer a motor
2 vehicle in violation of this act shall be subject to a fine of \$150.00
3 for a first offense and \$250.00 for each subsequent offense. Such
4 offense shall be prosecuted in the municipal or county district court.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
