AN ACT concerning county welfare boards and supplementing
Title 44 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The governing body of any county may*, *by resolution or*
2 *ordinance, as appropriate,** change the name of the county welfare
3 board to the county board of social services.

1 2. ***[Whenever]*** *For any county which has adopted a resolu-*
2 *tion or ordinance pursuant to section 1 of this act, whenever** the
3 term "county welfare board" appears in the statutes it shall
4 ***[include]*** *mean the* "county board of social services."

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
