AN ACT to amend "An act concerning alcoholic beverages; limiting the number of licenses to sell alcoholic beverages at retail, and supplementing chapter 1, Title 33, of the Revised Statutes," approved May 1, 1947 (P. L. 1947, c. 94).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 2. Except as otherwise provided in this act, no new plenary retail con-
4 sumption or seasonal retail consumption license shall be issued in a munici-
5 pality unless and until the combined total number of such licenses existing
6 in the municipality is fewer than 1 for each **[1,000]** *2,000* of its population
7 as shown by the last then preceding Federal census; and no new plenary
8 retail distribution license shall be issued in a municipality unless and until
9 the number of such licenses existing in the municipality is fewer than 1 for
10 each **[3,000]** *5,000* of its population as shown by the last then preceding
11 Federal census.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
