AN ACT concerning motor vehicles, and amending section 39:3-34 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 39:3-34 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-
2 lows:

3 39:3-34. No person whose registration certificate or operator's license
4 has been suspended or revoked shall apply to an agent of the commissioner
5 for another registration certificate or license, as the case may be, during the
6 period of the suspension or revocation. A person who violates this section
7 shall be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or
8 imprisonment for not more than three months, or both, at the discretion of
9 the court.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This amendment is designed to prevent the reregistration of an automobile whose registration has been suspended or revoked. This is equally as important as the preventing of the relicensing of drivers who have lost their right to operate an automobile.

7 shall be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or
8 imprisonment for not more than three months, or both, at the discretion of
9 the court.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
