A SUPPLEMENT to the "Spill Compensation and Control Act,"
approved January 6, 1977 (P. L. 1976, c. 141; C. 58:10-23.11
et seq.).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The State Auditor shall conduct an annual audit of the fund
2 pursuant to the provisions of chapter 24 of Title 52 of the Revised
3 Statutes. This audit, together with any recommendations on prac-
4 tices or procedures to promote or guarantee the fiscal integrity of
5 the fund, shall be submitted to the Governor and the Legislature,
6 and to the General Assembly Agriculture and Environment Com-
7 mittee and the Senate Energy and Environment Committee, or
8 their designated successors. The audit for fiscal year 1981 shall
9 be due within 60 days of the effective date of this act, and each
10 successive annual audit shall be due on ***【September 1】*** *or before*
11 *December 31*.*.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
