An Acr concerning truth-in-pricing and supplementing "An act concerning consumer fraud, its prevention, and providing penalties therefor, approved June 9, 1960," P. L. 1960, c. 39.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 1 1. It shall be an unlawful practice for any person to sell, attempt
